

TOP TIPS FOR YOUR PLASTICS & CANS

GETTING YOUR RECYCLING READY

START BY...



Checking your numbers. You can put plastics number 1, 2 & 5 in your crate. You can find the number on the bottom of most items.

> Remove ALL lids. Put them in your rubbish bin.



Make sure it's clean. Hot tip: Give everything a rinse at the end of doing your dishes. We've pulled together our top tips to make the most of your plastics & cans crate.

Why? Lids fall through the sorting machine and can get stuck in the system.



Get squashing! Squashing your plastic, tins and cans will give you more space in your crate.

With tins, we recommend pushing the lid into the tin itself and squeezing it.

FILLING YOUR CRATE



Stack trays together. Utilise space by stacking your smaller trays and containers in larger ones.



Stop at the top.

Overfull crates are a health and safety hazard for our team. If you've got lots of plastics & cans you might like to use more than one crate, or take excess to one of our transfer or recycling stations.

PUTTING OUT YOUR CRATE

Windy day? Put your glass crate on top of your plastics & cans to stop things blowing off.





KEEP IT KERBSIDE
