

HAVELOCK NORTH STREAMS SURVEY



The five streams in Havelock North that receive stormwater from the Havelock North dams were surveyed in March 2024.

Over five kilometers of stream and 14 structures along the Herehere, Mangarau, Te Kahika, School and Karituwhenua streams were scanned using a drone.

The important information provided by the survey will be used to inform future work, including:

- The modelling and performance of streams
- The design of solutions
- The condition assessment of assets
- communicating the challenges and opportunities.

Scan of structures

Scanning the structures which the streams pass under provides information on the capacity of each stream.

Next steps

Analysis of the data is still underway, as are further visualisation, archaeological investigation, site assessments, ecology work, and tree and vegetation assessment.

Council will share this analysis with the community once it is available.
