The following resolution was adopted and may now be actioned:

**8. HAVELOCK NORTH STREAMS AND DAMS - MANGARAU AND  
HEREHERE OPTIONS**  
(Copy circulated)

Councillor Lester/Councillor Twigg

- a) That the report of the Drainage Services Manager, Dave McBryde titled, Havelock North Streams – Mangarau and Herehere Options and dated 26 February 2004 be received.
- b) That the Works Committee approves further investigation of structural and non-structural options for the Mangarau and Herehere Streams.
- c) That up to \$18M be invested over a 20 year period with \$7.6M provided for high priority areas in the first 10 years.
- d) That the investment be, for the purpose of the LTTCP, funded by the general rate and alternative funding sources be considered.

With the reasons for this decision being that the objective of the decision will contribute to the following outcomes:

- i) Community well being by reducing the threats to life and property from erosion and flooding of the Mangarau and Herehere Streams.

- ii) **Delivery of essential services – stormwater, by ensuring that the stream has the capacity to safely convey runoff through the Havelock North urban area.**
- iii) **Environmental – by securing private and public assets from the effects of erosion and flooding and stabilising of the natural current of the streams.**
- iv) **Economic – by reducing damage and disruption from erosion and flooding.**
