

## HDC Streams Maintenance

Hastings District Council is responsible for the annual maintenance of the streams and drains which run across Hastings and Havelock North residential areas. The streams maintained are as follows:

Location plans of the various locations and scope of what is carried out is attached.

The maintenance includes the mowing, weed eating and spraying of these streams usually up to 5 times per year (depending upon growth within the stream) as well as the removal of any debris / trees which block the water ways from time to time, following calls from members of the public.

The maintenance work is currently carried out by the Hawkes Bay Regional Council works group and the maintenance is carried out throughout the year.

HDC carry out routine inspections throughout the year to look at the growth of weeds, grass, etc. and instruct the works group to carry out the maintenance.

HDC also carry out inspections following complaints received concerning trees and hedging within the water ways and arranging for their removal, again usually by HBRC works group and sometimes by tree arborists.

HDC organize stream protection works in some sections of the stream beds should erosion or slips occur.

HDC organizing routine maintenance of drainage reserve areas carried out by Recreational Services.
