DECISION

This is an application by Hastings District Council for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 201 Warren Street South, Hastings known as Hastings City Art Gallery.

The premises operate as an Art Gallery.

Reports were received from the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Licensing Inspector indicating no objection to the application.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

The Committee has considered the matters to which it is to have regard under section 105 of the Act and is satisfied that these are met. Accordingly the applicant is hereby granted an on-licence in respect of the premises known as Hastings District Council for a period of one year.

The applicant is advised to take note of the obligations imposed on them by the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 particularly in regard to the provision of food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks, the display of signs and of the licence, and the requirement to provide information regarding transport

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a. **No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not:**
 - i. **residing or lodging on the premises; or**
 - ii. **present on premises to dine.**

- b. **Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:**

Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 11.00 pm

- c. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.**
- d. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.**
- e. Drinking water is to be freely available and free of charge to customers at the following location while the premises are open for business: At the counter.**
- f. The host responsibility policy supplied with the application is to be fully complied with.**
- g. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.**
- h. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages.**
- i. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from licensed premises.**
- j. The licensed area is described in a plan date stamped as received by the Hastings District Licensing Committee on 29 October 2021.**
