DECISION

This is an application by **Hawkes Bay Clay Target Club Incorporated** for a renewal of a club licence in respect of premises situated at 1214 Maraekakaho Road Hastings known as **Hawkes Bay Clay Target Club**.

The premises operates as a Clay Target Cub.

Reports were received from the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Licensing Inspector indicating no objection to the application.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

The Committee has considered the matters to which it is to have regard under section 131 of the Act and is satisfied that these are met. Accordingly the applicant is hereby granted a renewal of the club licence for a period of three years from the date of expiry.

A replacement licence is to be issued.

The applicant is advised to take note of the obligations imposed on them by the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 particularly in regard to the provision of food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks, the display of signs and of the licence, and the requirement to provide information regarding transport

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The club must have a secretary at all times.**
- (b) Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the Secretary of the Hastings District Licensing Committee of the name of the new secretary.**
- (c) All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.**
- (d) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:**

- (e) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.**
- (f) The club committee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.**
- (g) Drinking water is to be freely available and free of charge to customers at the following location while the premises are open for business: At the bar.**
- (h) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.**
- (i) The club must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages.**
- (j) The club must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to members and guests from the premises.**
- (k) The Host Responsibility Policy for the premises is to be fully complied with.**
- (l) The licensed area is described in a plan date stamped as received by the Hastings District Licensing Agency on 11 November 2021.**
