**IN THE MATTER** of an application by **Hawkes Bay BBQ Limited** for temporary authority pursuant to s.136 of the Act in respect of premises situated at 1024 Pakowhai Road Hastings known as "**Bareknuckle Barbeque**".

**DECISION**

This is an application by **Hawkes Bay BBQ Limited** for temporary authority in respect of premises situated at 1024 Pakowhai Road Hastings known as "**Bareknuckle Barbeque**."

The premises operate as a **Restaurant**

Reports were received from the Police and Licensing Inspector indicating no objection to the application.

No objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Committee has considered the application and approval is granted for a period of three months pursuant to Section 136(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

That the applicant be advised that it is the expectation of the District Licensing Committee that an application for a substantive licence is to be made within six weeks of the issue of the temporary authority.

The Temporary Authority is issued, commencement date **1 July 2022 for a period of three months expiring on 1 October 2022** and subject to the following terms and conditions:

Pursuant to this temporary authority **Hawkes Bay BBQ Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 1024 Pakowhai Road Hastings known as "**Bareknuckle Barbeque**."

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

That the temporary authority shall have the following conditions:

- a. No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not:
  - i. residing or lodging on the premises; or
  - ii. present on premises to dine.
- b. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 12 midnight
- c. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- d. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- e. Drinking water is to be freely available and free of charge to customers at the following location while the premises are open for business: At the tables and at the bar.
- f. The host responsibility policy supplied with the application is to be fully complied with.
- g. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
- h. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages.
- i. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from licensed premises.
- j. The licensed area is described in a plan date stamped as received by the Hastings District Licensing Agency on 11 June 2020.
