DECISION

This is an application by **Hastings District Libraries** for a special licence in respect of **Late Night Which Craft Workshops** at premises situated at 201 Warren Street South Hastings known as **“Hastings War Memorial Library”**.

Reports were received from the Police and Medical Officer of Health indicating no objection to the application. A report was received from the Licensing Inspector indicating no objection to the application subject to the proposed conditions being imposed.

No objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

The Committee has considered the matters to which it is to have regard under section 142 of the Act and is satisfied that these are met. Accordingly the applicant is hereby granted a special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event:

Late Night Which Craft Workshops

CONDITIONS

The Special Licence be issued with the following conditions:

a. **Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:**

- b. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- i. There shall be no sale or supply to minors or intoxicated people.
 - ii. That the applicant fully complies with the undertakings and alcohol management plan provided in the application submitted dated 8 January 2025.
- c. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed:
- The premises are to be managed in respect of the sale and supply of alcohol by:
Emma Lord
- d. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business: at the tables.
- e. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows: nibbles.
- f. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows: Juices / coffee / tea.
- g. The licensee must take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises: Taxi Information
- h. The licensee must file with the District Licensing Committee returns relating to the sale of alcohol as follows: Nil.
- i. The operation of this licence is subject to random inspection by the Hastings Police and/or Inspector of the Hastings District Council.
- j. Members of the public shall be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
- On the request of any member of the New Zealand Police or Inspector of the Hastings District Council.
