The welfare of everyone in our community during these Level 4 restrictions continues to be our top priority.

From today, our Hawke's Bay Civil Defence Emergency Management Group has activated a free public phone number for anyone needing urgent help to access essential household goods and services.

The Hawke's Bay welfare helpline is 0800 422 923 (between 7am – 7pm)

Staying home is still really important. Everyone needs to keep within their isolation bubbles and only go out if absolutely necessary.

Getting outside for some fresh air and exercise must be done within your local neighbourhood and only with people inside your bubble. This is not the time to be meeting up in large groups for a cycle ride or a run. Please help us to break the chain of COVID-19 and save lives!
