Our waste minimisation team has created a flood-damaged disposal guide for residential/lifestyle properties and small businesses looking to get rid of specific items as they clean up. The guide provides safe disposal options for things like paint, concrete, timber and chemicals.

This guide is intended for residential or lifestyle properties and small businesses.

We recommend contacting the business prior to dropping off. This way you can check their capacity and see if they have any specific instructions or limitations. e.g. room for large trucks.

For large commercial volumes, check with your relevant industry organisation and/or current waste collection provider. Some of the businesses listed may be able to take larger volumes, so call and ask.

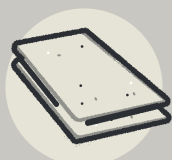
