What's happening?

We're working to redevelop the 200 West block. With the two locations 223 Heretaunga Street West and 206 Queen Street West we'll be using the space to create: quality inner city housing, a car park, a public space with a pocket park and a pedestrian laneway.

Why

The redevelopment is designed to:

- create more inner city green spaces
- enhance connections around the city
- celebrate culture in the city
- tell our story through design
- add to our housing options
- showcase how inner city housing can work.

It's just one of many projects in the Hastings City Centre Revitalisation Plan.

THE RESOURCE CONSENT

Council has lodged a resource consent - this was publicly notified on Saturday 8 October.

When a resource consent is publicly notified, you have the opportunity to give feedback by making a submission. You can make a submission on all or part of a resource consent application. It can be in favour, in opposition, neutral or a combination.

You have 20 working days to make a submission from the date of notification. Submissions will close on Monday 7 November at 5pm.

Before making a submission it's important to read all of the information provided and ensure you understand what the application is about and what the effects are likely to be.
