Mr Chief Executive,

I was disappointed to read in the paper a suggestion to reduce the number of councillors.

Hastings District covers a huge area and is not a tiny compact city like Wellington. I support 2 rural councillors. The rural area that is under the Hastings District Council could not be represented fairly by only one councillor. Compared with Havelock North, where residential homes are contained in a small area, the rural area is wide reaching and too large for one Councillor to effectively represent all the ratepayers. Very little travel in Havelock North – large amount of travelling in the rural areas. It must take 2-3 hours to cross the whole district.

Flaxmere with a high Maori voting population will be represented by one councillor and will also have the support of 3 new Maori Councillors. Therefore to have a fair and equitable voice in Council the Rural Community must be also represented by two Hastings District Councillors. There will be very upset rural ratepayers if the Council is seen to be diminishing their voice.

I served as a Councillor on the Hastings District Council for a period of fifteen years from 2001 to 2016 and on the Rural Community Board from 2001 to 2018. I was also the Chair of the National Executive Committee for Community Boards from 2009 to 2018. During my period on the National Executive, I became very familiar with the Representation Review procedure, and have acted in support of submitters for other Councils in a number of appeals before the Appeal Authority. I am currently advising submitters in Tauranga and Southern Wairarapa.

I have read the draft proposal that has been considered and issued by the Hastings District Council asking for submissions.

I support the proposal in its present form.

As a past long serving rural Councillor and Community Board member for the rural community, I particularly support the representation that has been recommended for the rural area. To give any thought, as I suspect some urban Councillors may have in their mind, to reduce either the Councillor numbers or the Board members, would in my opinion be a very retrograde step.

There are two main matters which must be considered. The first is the geographical size of the rural area of the Hastings District. The current representation of both Councillors and Board members is light enough and puts heavy demands on all elected members to deal with wide ranging issues over an extensive area. Secondly the issues raised are often of a particularly rural nature, and it takes someone with a rural background, to both understand them and then work with officers to achieve a practical and monetarily efficient solution.

In essence, the Rural Councillors and Board members represent a particular community of interest and deal with matters outside the knowledge and experience of urban Councillors.

I am happy to appear before the Council in support of this submission.

Hastings District Council Representation Review Submission Ngäti Kahungunu lwi Incorporated

Tēnā koe,

Ngāti Kahungunu Iwi Incorporated (NKII) is the mandated Ngāti Kahungunu authority with interests in all aspects of Ngāti Kahungunu development. The rohe of Ngāti Kahungunu includes Hastings District Council area in its entirety. Ngāti Kahungunu has the third largest iwi population (62,000¹) in the country and over 36,000 registered members and is inclusive of all hapū within the district of Hastings.

- 1. Ngāti Kahungunu lwi Incorporated support the representation arrangements proposed by Hastings District Council. Including:
 - a. total number of Councillors:
 - b. number of Māori seats:
 - c. establishment of 1 Māori Ward:
 - d. the Inclusion of one Councillor from the proposed Takitimu Ward being appointed on the Hastings District Rural Community Board.
- 2. In addition, NKII also support exploring further representation for Flaxmere, for example a Community Board or any other mechanism that the community of Flaxmere might propose.
- 3. The total number of Councillors mirrors the current number of Councillors, that were established after the previous comprehensive process. The proposed number also caters for 3 Māori representatives.
- 4. The proposed number of Māori seats provides for reasonable spread of views and interests from within the Hastings Māori population. The likely burden on a sole Māori representative to carry the weight would also be minimised.
- 5. One M\u00e4ori ward enables the best opportunity for the 3 best candidates to be appointed, as opposed to multiple wards essentially splitting the candidates, due to likely arbitrary spatial boundaries. It also is preferable and more equitable given the spread of M\u00e4ori and their whakapapa across Hastings.
- 6. Further support and consideration for Flaxmere is warranted due to the proposed ward having the greatest population per member (via General Electoral Population) and the need to address poor social and economic statistics of the ward.

Ngāti Kahungunu Iwi Incorporated acknowledge Hastings District Council and their positive steps towards enabling greater participation of Māori and tangata whenua in local government decision making.

This submission is written on behalf of the Maungaharuru-Tangitū Trust (MTT). MTT is the post-settlement governance entity representing a collective of hapū including — Marangatūhetaua (Ngāti Tū), Ngāti Whakaari, Ngāi Tauira, Ngāti Kurumökihi (formerly known as Ngāi Tatara), Ngāi Te Ruruku ki Tangoio and Ngāi Tahu (Hapū). The takiwā (traditional area) of the MTT Hapū encompasses the Waitaha River in the north to Keteketerau in the south (the outlet of the earlier Te Whanganui-ā-Orotu also known as the Napier Inner Harbour which was in existence before the 1931 Napier earthquake), and from the Maungaharuru Range in the west to the coast and beyond to Tangitū (the sea) in the east. The marae of the Hapū is Tangoio Marae located approximately 20km of Napier. MTT is mandated by the Hapū to be their voice and representative body.

Proportionate Representation and Number of Councillors

We acknowledge that the Local Election Act 2001 (LEA) provides no discretion as to the number of councillors elected from Māori wards which may be established by the HDC. However, in our view

the formula set out for proportional representation in the LEA is not consistent with the principle of partnership under Te Tiriti o Waitangi. Instead, we consider that principle requires Māori and non-Māori be elected in equal numbers rather than merely in proportion to the number of voters registered on the Māori and general electorates.

Therefore, HDC should ensure that the proportion of Māori councillors is as high as possible within the limits of the LEA to better reflect that true partnership would require equivalent representation of Māori and non-Māori on the HDC. On that basis we prefer the number of councillors remain at 14 rather than increasing the number of councillors by the number of Māori councillors so as to avoid further diluting the influence of Māori in local government. While MTT acknowledges HDC is only increasing the number of councillors by one instead of increasing the number of councillors by the number of Māori wards, MTT considers this does act to dilute the influence of councillors elected in the Māori wards.

Number of Māori wards

MTT is concerned that by only providing for one Māori ward, Māori within the Hastings District will not be best represented. However, MTT intends to clarify is position on the number of wards over the following days and update HDC on that position.

Naming of wards

The name of the Möhaka ward does not sufficiently represent the communities within that ward. The ward extends as far south as Hastings to as far north as the Waikari River. A name should be selected which better represents the community that is included within that ward. We suggest that an appropriate name be sought from kaumātua who are mana whenua within that ward, and that the relevant PSGEs and Taiwhenua can provide the names of kaumātua who will be able to assist.

In conclusion we make the following recommendations:

- 1. That there are a total of 14 councillors.
- 2. The name of the Mōhaka ward be amended to better reflect the community represented.
- 3. The names for the Mōhaka ward and the Māori ward(s) be selected by kaumātua who are mana whenua within those wards (as advised by the relevant PSGEs and Taiwhenua).

Further to our previous submission, MTT considers that HDC should split the "Takitimu" Māori ward in to three separate Māori wards as detailed in option 2 on pages 18 and 19 of the HDC Representation Review First Discussion Document dated June/July 2021. While we acknowledge this may result in disparate representation between electorates, we consider that voters on the Māori roll living in rural communities (including at Arapawanui and Tangoio) are a sufficiently distinct group with a distinct set of interests which justifies separate representation from voters on the Māori roll living in urban areas. We appreciate this is a late further submission but we hope, having flagged that we would be making a late response on this point in our original submission, that HDC will take this into consideration.

I am writing to oppose the Council's representation proposal.

Firstly I would like to congratulate the council's decision to introduce Maori wards earlier this year. It shows the Council's understanding and clear intent to meet the requirement of the Local Government Act 2002to facilitate participation by Māori in local authority decision-making processes.

However, I oppose the Council's Initial Proposal for the following reasons:

1. It does not comply with the ±"rule" and in doing so under represents an already vulnerable community.

It is the Council's obligation to ensure effective representation for identified communities of interest and to find a distribution of councillors that fits within the $\pm 10\%$. The Initial Proposal fails to do this.

The council's decision not to comply with this rule is flawed and borders on being undemocratic.

The Council is clearly aware that the introduction of a Māori Ward has meant that the Māori electoral population has been removed from the electoral populations of each of the general wards. This impacts particularly on Flaxmere where 40% of the electoral population of the current Flaxmere Ward is transferred to the Takitimu Ward.

The Council's Initial Proposal fails to address this impact. Under the Proposal Flaxmere is under represented by 14%. In presenting this Proposal the Council has clearly confused its obligations to meet the interests of Maori and the interests of the community of Flaxmere. The Council's decision to under represent Flaxmere appears to be based on the flawed and undemocractic premise that meeting the interests of Maori (through the Maori Ward) will meet the interests of the community of Flaxmere.

Flaxmere is already a politically disengaged and vulnerable group, it makes no sense to under represent them.

As a previous resident of Flaxmere I have observed first-hand the severe deprivation it's people face. I have also observed a traditional under investment by Council in Flaxmere.

While the current Council has demonstrated a commitment to spend within Flaxmere, this support is not guaranteed beyond this term. The only way to ensure ongoing Council support of Flaxmere is through good representation.

I am deeply concerned that Council's representation proposal not only disadvantages our most vulnerable community but may also justify this using a process that disenfranchises the very people who are most impacted.

When considering this (and other) submissions please keep in mind that the representation process is foreign to many within Flaxmere and will likely lead to low engagement from this ward, despite them being the most impacted.

Silence from Flaxmere is not the same as approval.

2. We need greater diversity on Council.

A measure of a good democracy is anyone who is legally able to stand or vote being able to do so. Increasing the number of councillors will contravene this.

We need to ensure that our Council is structured to "effectively represent" it's communities of interest by having a Council that looks more like the communities it represents. This means more elected members with their whole live ahead of them and greater ethnic diversity.

Fewer (not more) councillors will mean better paid individuals (encouraging diversity) who can focus more fully on the needs of the district, providing for more effective representation for all AND greater accountability.

I do not support increasing the number of councillors.

3. We should separate the Havelock North and Hastings wards.

Having dedicated Hastings and Havelock North councillors will provide a closer link to communities of interest, improved clarity over who to contact and greater tilizati accountability.

I understand that it was a matter of percentages that combined our wards in the past. However, the time has come to separate these two communities again.

Like most Havelock North residents, I find that everything I need is in my suburb. We have shops, places to dine, schools and essential services (such as healthcare). We are an easily identified area. While it is true that many people who live in Havelock North work and use services outside of our suburb, it is tenuous to suggest this is a reason to be linked with Hastings. Such employment and service tilization is often spread throughout the region (e.g. Napier, Clive, Haumoana, Hastings, etc) and not exclusively in Hastings.

Havelock North also has different demographics (particularly affluence) when compared to other areas in Hastings. The needs of our community are often not the same as those in Hastings.

It makes sense to give Hastings and Havelock North the same dedicated representation that all other wards currently have by separating the wards.

I am disappointed to see the Council has not addressed this Proposal with the same foresight it has been renown for in other areas. I understand that Council has other representation options it can consider. I oppose the current proposal.

- 1. I believe that we need greater diversity on our council. Well done for instigating the Māori wards the right move. Unfortunately our councils have been overly represented by white, older males (the demographic I sit in!) and that does not in any way reflect our diverse society. The system allows this to happen and I feel we do not need more councillors but having a Council that looks more like the communities it represents. Less is better, not more. I would prefer elected members with their whole lives (younger, connected and perhaps less traditional!) ahead of them and hopefully with greater ethnic diversity. If we had fewer councillors we therefore could pay our councillors more (spread the dollars, buy equity and make it happen) and by doing this we encourage more people to stand and represent their communities, be accountable and get things done. Dollars does make a difference and if we need to spend to get the diversity we need, then do it. Democracy and the voting system will still sort who gets to council. I do not support increasing the number of councillors.
- 2. Keep councillors connected to their communities accountable and visible. (A) Flaxmere will be under-represented, must have 2 councillors. It is a community that needs on-going effective representation not less. Being politically disengaged, often silent and vulnerable needs to be accepted, acknowledged and given the district support it needs. (B) Havelock North should be represented by a councillor who directly represents that community, so take that one out of the Hastings 'Ward' Note: Affluent areas like Havelock North have voice through many non council avenues they are not silent, disengaged or vulnerable. It makes sense to give Hastings and Havelock North the dedicated representation that all other wards currently have. I do not support the Council's initial proposal for district representation. I do not believe that the proposal provides fair and effective representation to our community for the following reasons.

1) The Havelock North and Hastings areas should have separate wards.

As a Hastings ratepayer, I am concerned that ALL of the elected representatives could be from Havelock North in any given election. Fair and unbiased representation means a guarantee that those who are elected to represent me and the Hastings community understand my area, views and needs. Havelock North is primarily an area of wealth, while much of Hastings is not. Both locales have their shopping and dining districts, schools and health services. They are easily geographically distinguishable. Therefore, there is no reason for them to remain merged. However, by separating out the wards, I will know which elected individuals to contact when I have a problem, and I can have faith they will be serving the area I live in, not their personal agenda.

2) Fewer councillors means more time dedicated to our district.

I understand that the current and proposed Council structure means that councillors only work part-time and are remunerated accordingly. However, I would prefer that we have fewer elected individuals who spend more time governing and being accountable to ratepayers instead of working on businesses, other boards, etc., to make ends meet. Therefore, in the interests of accountability and increased diversity, let's maintain or reduce the number of councillors. Fewer councillors who are paid well removes barriers for those who may not afford to stand. In addition, this reduction should lead to a more excellent selection of candidates to give fair and effective representation to the people of Hastings.

3) Flaxmere will be underrepresented.

It concerns me greatly that the Council's initial proposal disadvantages a diverse community such as Flaxmere. Flaxmere is a high needs area that is seeing massive growth – driven by the housing crisis. There seems little justification to underrepresent this vital community. In doing so, we risk the loss of proper process and fair representation. I wonder whether this proposal would reach the public consultation stage if the same measure underrepresented Havelock North.

The current and proposed ward structure puts the fair and effective representation of Hastings and Havelock North ratepayers at risk. Therefore, I'm afraid I disagree with the Council's representation proposal, and I urge the Council to consider other representation options.

As a member of the community, I am very concerned with the proposed changes that the Hastings District Council has put forward in its representation review. I believe your proposed changes serve the objectives of the current, and majoritally "well off" councillors, rather than those of the wider community they represent.

If you consider the make up of the current council members, it seems blatantly obvious that the younger, less wealthy, and therefore most vunerable members of our community are not being represented proportionately. Therefore their voices are not being heard. Or they having to shout much, much louder, than the older and wealthier members of our community, just to be heard. This is diproportianate, and not how I believe our council should respond and engage to "all" members of it's community, and their differing needs and circumstances.

It is my sincere desire to see more focus on achieving better age, and socio-economic representation, at the council table. This way our young, and less well off voters, can see themselves, and their unique interests reflected in those who speak for the community. Contrary to these goals, council's representation proposal will make standing for local government even less viable for young, or financially disadvantaged people.

It is also my desire to see more diversity in our councillors, so that all parts of our community are heard. The current model has too many barriers for the less wealthy, and younger members of our community to be represented by someone who has actual empathy for their situation.

In order to run for council, the current model sees potential candidates having to build a profile with voters, fundraising to run a campaign and the logistics and affordability to do the role, if elected. The first two of those barriers can be overcome, the last is more challenging.

The current structure of the Hastings District Council (14 councillors) makes it most suited to those who are independently wealthy or can subsidize their income by other means, such as running a business or (as is the case with 50 per cent of our council), receive superannuation. This issue will only be compounded if the proposal to further increase the number of Hastings councillors is adopted, due to the effect this will have on salary.

It is my understanding that the amount councillors are paid is decided by the Remuneration Authority, an independent body that allocates a fixed amount of money that each council can use to pay its mayor and councillors. For Hastings, this amount is \$798,640. The minimum remuneration of a councillor is currently \$43,765 per year (with the mayor earning over \$150,000 per year).

Importantly, increasing the size of council doesn't change the salary allocation, it simply means the pool of money is split among even more people – decreasing the amount each councillor is paid.

This further entrenches the role of councillor as primarily accessible to those who are wealthy, have a flexible alternative job or are retired. Council can apply to have the remuneration pool increased – but why would this be approved if on paper the role is now smaller as work is spread across more councillors?

Those under the age of 40 live in a very different world from their predecessors. Most of those in generations Y and Z will start their adult life with crippling student loans, a burden generally not faced by the generations before.

The promise of gainful employment through hard work and study is no longer a guarantee. With the over-priced and rare nature of rental houses, an average house price of \$700,000 in Hastings and ever-rising food and fuel costs – the minimum wage does not suffice (presently \$41,600 p/a).

Anyone without an alternative source of income would struggle to live off their councillor salary alone – which is close to minimum wage.

While being a Hastings District councillor is considered a part-time role, the ever-varying days and times at which council related events and meetings are held, almost exclusively during normal working hours, makes working another job on top of being on council generally unfeasible, unless you own the business. For young people, even more so.

It's little wonder then that more than 60 per cent of the current Hastings District Council councillors are over the age of 60, while only 23 per cent of Hastings residents are over 60. This is a huge representation imbalance, and I can only see it getting worse should the number of councillors increase, and the pay be decreased accordingly.

If anything, I support decreasing the number of councillors. Council was presented with an option to reduce the overall council to just 12 councillors plus the mayor, but council chose not to vote for this change.

During the meeting at which council debated the options to consult on, an older councillor argued that reducing the number of seats on council would disadvantage young people – giving us fewer chances to be elected. However, I do not agree. There is plenty of evidence nationally that demonstrates that when young people who have the necessary skills stand, they tend to get elected.

The problem we have locally is those aged 40 and younger cannot afford to stand and those who have been on council for a decade or longer seem unwilling to make room for fresh blood and ideas. The pay isn't attractive to younger, skilled and experienced residents who would likely take big pay cuts should they choose to stand. It's not good enough.

'Option C' which would have reduced the number of councillors was the only option presented to council that didn't result in any communities being overrepresented or underrepresented (unlike the current proposal that leaves Flaxmere proportionally underrepresented).

In my view, this option would increase councillor accountability to their constituents, facilitate more efficient decision making and encourage greater diversity on council by enabling those who are not retired or wealthy to consider standing.
Should being a community representative be reserved for only the wealthy or retired?
I believe we need more diversity on our council and that is why I donot support your proposal.
To be clear, I actively applaud the introduction of Māori wards, which statutorily requires council to conduct a 'representation review'. However,
I do not support the current proposal.
